Position & Responsibilities

Role Summary

Tubman's *North Star Youth Outreach Center* connects youth and young adults 13-24 of all genders (and their children, if parenting) to basic needs and resources. Youth are able to receive a range of services including 1:1 advocacy, safety planning, and connections to resources provided by Tubman and partner agencies. Volunteers provide customized and comprehensive support services, including a computer lab, shower, laundry, clothing, food, creative art, recreation, and meditation spaces.

- Follow agency guidelines as you interact with clients to identify their needs and strengths
- Communicate and collaborate to provide coordinated services to clients

Qualifications & Expectations

Position Qualifications:

- Previous relevant experience and enjoy working with youth and young adults
- Comfort working under pressure, able to remain calm in response to difficult situations
- Strong communication and people skills, including respect for diverse backgrounds and cultures, empathy, flexibility, patience, quickly engaging with people, and the ability to build on strengths
- Interest and attentiveness to fostering a culturally inclusive environment

- One 4-hour shift a week for a minimum of nine months preferred Days and times of available shifts are as follows:
